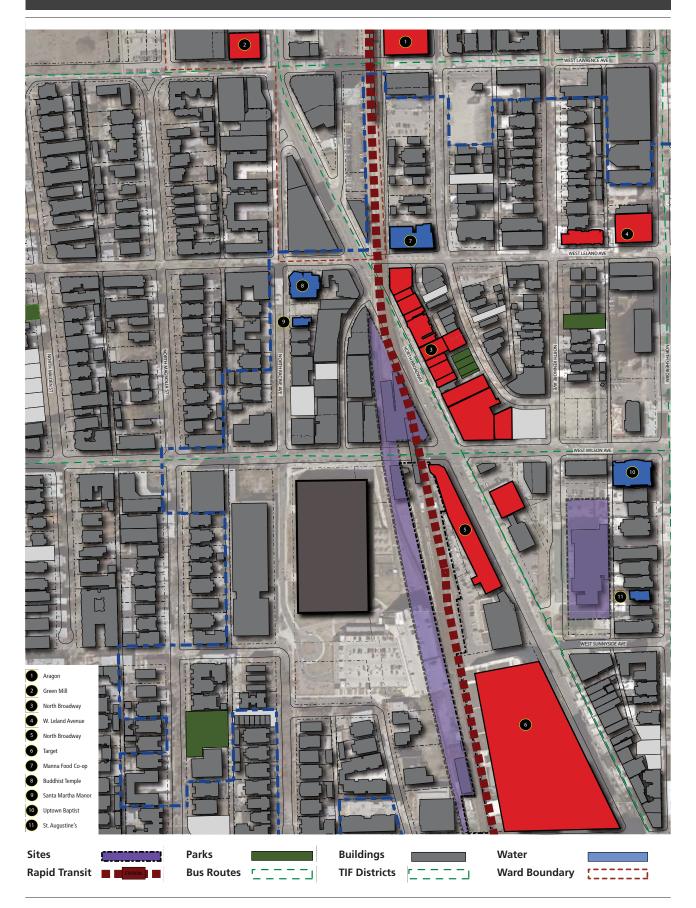
THE NEIGHBORHOOD

12+ stories 140+ feet

High-rise apartments Apartment over commercial Multi-use building

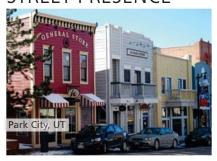






Can this be for more than one user group? Age? Income level? Can it be used in the evening? At night?

STREET PRESENCE

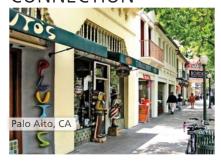






Can this have an identity and image? Can this place be welcoming and inviting from the street?

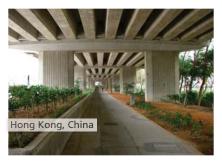


What types of activities might fit under the tracks? What more does the neighborhood need?
